The questions and his responses are below.

1. The LES environmental report states that there is a stocked pond on the Wallach Quarry that is adjacent, and to the north, of the proposed LES facility. He was requested to verify this statement. Mr. Wallach stated that there was a pond stocked with fish for recreational purposes at the quarry. The stocked pond was for personal use only (family and friends) and they only used it as a catch-and-release pond. They fish the pond year-round. He stated that if the stocked pond was something that would prevent LES from obtaining a license, that he would remove it.

2. Mr. Wallach was asked if there were any milk farms near the LES facility. He stated that all milk farms in the region were north of Hobbs, NM and there were none near the proposed LES site.

3. Mr. Wallach was asked if he knew who owned Site 33, the strip of land that was between the LES/quarry sites and the NM/Texas state line. He stated that all of that property was owned by WCS.

Mr. Wallach concluded that he would be happy to answer any additional questions if the need arose.
