In conformance with the Commission's policy on notification of the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board of new, relevant, and material information, this memorandum provides the information discussed below.

The attached Draft Environmental Impact Statement for the Proposed National Enrichment Facility in Lea County, New Mexico, NUREG-1790, issued by the staff of the U. S.
