Action Items

- No action items from June 24, 2004 meeting

Status/Schedule Adherence

- NRC beat schedule for issuing the draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS)
- Application revision that incorporated most of the clarifications/details in responses to Requests for Additional Information (RAIs) and corrected errata was submitted on July 30, 2004
- Responses to NRC requests for follow-up clarifications have been provided on a timely basis
- Application revision that separates the Integrated Safety Analysis Summary from the Safety Analysis Report was submitted on September 30, 2004

Issues Being Addressed

- Memorandum of Understanding (MOV) for treatment of cultural sites
 - MOV to be issued to signatories/concurrence parties
- Integrated Safety Assessment
 - Provided detailed information on safe-by-design components that followed the NRC-LES agreed upon content
 - Prepared to answer any follow-on questions so that review can be completed expeditiously
- Foreign Ownership, Control, or Influence (FOCI) review
 - Concerned that Department of Energy FOCI reviewers may not understand NRC policy regarding foreign ownership of enrichment plants or Quadripartite Agreement

Architect / Engineer

- Announcement of A/E selection issued on August 3, 2004.
- Contract has not been executed due to issues regarding liability
- Pursuing other potential resolutions

Feedback

- Good cooperation
- Good communications
- Excellent progress
 - Draft EIS issued ahead of schedule
 - Letter of appreciation submitted
 - Safe-by-design issue coming to resolution
- Attention still needed
 - FOCl review
