This letter pertains to proposed revisions to Parts 1, 3, 4, 5, 16 and 19 of the State of Colorado *Rules and Regulations Pertaining to Radiation Control*. The proposed rules with and without strikeout will be found at <http://www.cdphe.state.co.us/hm/rad/regs/rules.asp>. For comparison, the rules now in effect are at <http://www.cdphe.state.co.us/op/regs/radiationregs.asp>.

Electronic copies of the proposed regulations were provided to John Zabko of your office in August 2004. Electronic copies of Parts 1, 3, 4, and 19, modified by Colorado staff in part based on NRC staff comments and suggestions this week, have also been provided to John Zabko and Bill Rautzen of NRC.

The hearing on adoption is scheduled for November 17, 2004. Your prior review of the October revised final proposed regulation would be greatly appreciated.

These changes to Parts 1, 3, 4, 5, 16, and 19 incorporate all equivalent amendments to NRC's regulations and also incorporate, as required by Colorado's Radiation Control Act, available corresponding language from the *Suggested State Regulations for the Control of Radiation*, in particular Parts A, C, D, E, O, P, Q, S (as proposed), and W.

We believe that adoption of these revisions satisfies the compatibility and health and safety categories established in the Office of State and Tribal Programs (STP) Procedure SA-200.
