The NRC issued Order EA-03-039 (Reference 1) dated April 29, 2003, requiring compliance with Compensatory Measures Related to Training Enhancements on Tactical and Fire Arms Proficiency and Physical Fitness Applicable to Armed Nuclear Power Plant Security Force Personnel, to Entergy Nuclear Operations Inc., (ENO) for the James A. Fitzpatrick Nuclear Power Plant (JAF). ENO responded to that order (Reference 2) stating, "Entergy is implementing, subject to the relief requested in the form of clarifications, the requirements in Attachment 2 to Order EA-03-039 and shall complete implementation as set forth below, fully training and qualifying all armed security force personnel on the new requirements no later than October 29, 2004."


