This refers to your license amendment requests dated September 17, 2004, and November 18, 2004. Additional information was obtained during a phone call, on November 22, 2004, between Mr. Joseph Nick, of this office, and Ms. Jane Fisher, of your office. The additional information was required to determine the authorization for two users on the amendment request. Since the certifications for both individuals from the American Board of Radiology were for diagnostic radiology, the authorization for use of radioactive materials was changed to all uses permitted by 10 CFR 35.100 and 35.200. Enclosed with this letter is the amended license.

Please note that future amendment requests should be signed by a member of your senior management.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand and fully implement all the conditions incorporated into the amended license. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region I Office, Licensing Assistance Team, (610) 337-5239, so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.
