Subject: Use of portable gauges at CERCLA site			
<p>Summary:</p> <p>The above named individuals call to discuss the use of portable gauges at a site that is designated a CERCLA site (in NJ). They stated that their understanding is that any material may be used at a CERCLA site without having a license. They also stated that the site is a large area and they may have to transport the gauges from one area to another on public roads and if they need a license to transport the gauges on public roads.</p> <p>I asked them that how can they possess gauges without a license. They confirmed that they do have a license (listed above) and the license authorizes use of gauges at temporary job sites, but were not sure if it included CERCLA sites as well.</p> <p>I told them that I can not give a legal interpretation of the requirements but my understanding of the regulations is that the CERCLA site would be a temporary job site and the licensee will be required to provide security of the gauges and ensure use of the gauges in accordance with regulatory requirements, including any required record keeping.</p> <p>I told them that the licenses also authorize transport of licensed material in accordance with DOT requirements. They stated that they understand the requirements.</p>
