
This letter transmits our response to the September 2, 2004 letter to Keith Connelly from the Probabilistic Safety Assessment Branch of the NRC. As stated in the September 2, 2004 NRC request for information, the NRC has made a preliminary determination, in accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 2.390 of Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations, that the information requested and the SDP notebooks may relate to a plant's physical protection. In accordance with this determination, the information in attachment 1 and the information on the CD have been marked as "proprietary information" and should be withheld from public disclosure.

The September 2, 2004 letter has been discussed with the Project Manager for Callaway Plant. A response date of November 30, 2004 was agreed to in the discussion with the Project Manager.

Attachment 1 is Callaway Plant's response to the September 2, 2004 letter and per NRC's request we have also provided the information on the enclosed CD. A CD has also been sent to the Probabilistic Safety Assessment Branch.
