

Following a review of License No. 52-01986-01 (Docket No. 030-01182), I found that the file in the Docket Room only contains licensing information until 1994. The license was issued in 1959, and so there is substantially more history than contained in this file. The decommissioning survey that was sent on 9/28/04 contains survey results for 2 storage rooms and some previously-used laboratories. When the license was issued, it approved the use of numerous unsealed radionuclides for "greenhouse and field experiments". In 1966, the use of carbon-14 in pesticides was approved. From the available docket file, it is unclear if these materials were used in locations other than the laboratories indicated in the surveys. These materials were removed from the license in 1978, but there is no available documentation as to the disposition of the materials or of any applicable field sites. On 12/28/04, I requested retrieval of the archived information for this license to determine if additional surveys are required.
