Dear Administrative Judges:

The purpose of this letter is to update the Board on the status of the above-captioned proceeding. On November 30, 2004, Sequoyah Fuels Corporation ("SFC") entered into a Settlement Agreement with Oklahoma and the Cherokee Nation in the proceeding before the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Tenth Circuit. The Tenth Circuit approved the parties' jointly filed Stipulation to Dismiss the proceeding, and ordered the dismissal on December 9, 2004. Under these circumstances, SFC has advised the NRC Staff that it will shortly be filing a motion to request withdrawal of the decommissioning plan and terminate this proceeding.
