<p>Summary:</p> <p>In a response to a deficiency letter sent on December 14, 2004, Cardinal Health has requested that remodeling be approved before they send in survey results. I called to ensure that I am understanding that the request is indeed to remodel one part of the facility, relocate the equipment in the restricted area which is to become unrestricted, then survey. He confirmed that the remodeling, which will include an expansion, needs to be completed so that the equipment in the restricted area (which will become an unrestricted area) can be moved and then they can decommission the area which will become unrestricted.</p> <p>I also reminded Mr Bruening that Cardinal health is required, by regulation, to monitor those individuals contracted for the remodeling job and keep records for them. He stated that Cardinal Health will monitor the contractors and keep records.</p>
