The current license authorizes CS-137, H-3 and Pm-147 do you still wish these authorized on license. If so give specifics or if not provided info describing proper disposal/transfer.</li> <li>4. The current license authorizes use of RAM at the New Kensington, PA facility. Your application does not request this place of use. If you wish to delete this facility you will need to provide decommissioning information for our review. We can renew the license as is and you may request that the Kensington facility be released at a later date once you have obtained all necessary information. You must comply with Part 30 time requirements for release of facility.</li> <li>5. In order to obtain SSD sheets you will need to contact the manufacturer.</li> <li>6. Item of your application states that non routine maintenance will be performed by the manufacturer or other approved persons. Your current license authorizes Jim Szalanski to perform some non routine maintenance. Confirm whether you wish to retain this authorization or go with what is stated in the application.</li> </ol>
