Subject: Bergen Diagnostic Management Nuclear, LLC			
<p>Summary:</p> <p>Mr. Shepard sent a letter dated January 17, 2005, to NRC on behalf of his client, John S. Pantazopoulos, MD. Dr. Pantazopoulos is the original owner of the license. Dr. Pantazopoulos took on partners and the name of the licensee was changed to Bergen Diagnostic Management Nuclear, LLC. Mr. Shepard stated that Dr. Pantazopoulos was cut out of the day-to-day operation and locked out of the facility. Dr. Pantazopoulos recently received a notice of non-payment of the annual fee and he wanted to know what other problems he, the original licensee, was having with NRC.</p> <p>I spoke with Karl Farrar about the letter prior to contacting Mr. Shepard.</p> <p>I told Mr. Shepard that we had not inspected the facility since December 2003 and it was not due for inspection until 2008. Mr. Shepard did not indicate there were any problems at the facility. I told him in our experience these situations happened occasionally and the problem was usually worse because the person excluded was the RSO or the only authorized user. In Dr. Pantazopoulos' case he is neither. I gave Mr. Shepard the telephone number for Billy Blaney in HQ so he could check on the status of any fees that might be owed NRC. Based on the recommendation of Karl Farrar, I also told Mr. Shepard that, if Dr. Pantazopoulos was not involved with the licensed program, he may want to work with his partners to transfer the license to them.</p>
