Dear Mr. Desgagne:


In accordance with your request (reference a.) and pursuant to R313-19-30, you are hereby authorized to use radioactive materials at the temporary job sites you have specified, provided the job sites are not in areas under exclusive Federal jurisdiction. The use of radioactive materials shall be conducted in accordance with your representations in reference a., the Utah Radiation Control Rules (R313-19-30), and your Radioactive Material License (reference b.).

You are expected to notify our office in a timely manner of a change that affects the information provided in the initial reciprocity request, allowing us sufficient time to carry out our statutory mandate of ensuring that sources of radiation are adequately controlled.

Special Condition(s):

The authorization contained herein is not effective after December 31, 2005, or 180 possession days in a calendar year, whichever occurs earlier.
