Your December 8, 2004 letter appears to be a request to terminate your license. We need additional information:

1. A completed [and signed] Form 314, "Certificate of Disposition of Materials". This indicates if you do or do not possess any material at this time, and whether material was transferred to another licensee, or disposed of. This form can be downloaded from the NRC web site, [www.nrc.gov](http://www.nrc.gov) . From the home page at the left, you will see a button "Forms" which will give you access to all standard NRC forms.
2. Results of surveys of your facilities that demonstrate that no areas of residual contamination remain. If your routine surveys are sufficiently detailed, you may use results of such surveys, provided they were done after all material was disposed of or transferred.
