Subject: Non-receipt of renewal application.		
<p><u>Summary:</u> I spoke with Ms. Exline about the non-receipt of a renewal application. Ms. Exline indicated that the company is in the process of disposing of the unit. I informed her that the process of disposal may take more time then remains on the term of the license. The licensee is required to renew the license because they possess licensed material but there will be no fee required of the licensee for the application. I asked Ms. Exline if they would be replacing the unit. She stated that they had received a new unit but that she was not named on the license. I requested that she look at the ECD of the unit and confirm that it was tagged with a label indicating that the device was possessed under the authority of 10 CFR 31.5. If it was so tagged, then she could request a license for storage only pending the disposition of the unit. The licensee would need to submit a request to terminate the license once the unit was disposed of and include a Certificate of Disposition of Materials describing to whom the unit was sent and a copy of the last leak test report, and a confirmation letter from the recipient.</p> <p>09:15 Matt Page called and wanted to confirm what information was necessary to terminate the license. I provided him with the information. He also stated that he had confirmed that the new unit was possessed under a general license and that the Perkin Elmer ECD had been transferred to a waste disposal firm. The required information would be sent in as quickly as possible.</p>
