<p><u>Summary:</u> I was informed that Dr. Kovacs was performing hospital rounds. The receptionist patched me through to the nuclear medicine technologist. John Sienrukos, nuclear medicine technologist, stated that operations under Dr. Kovacs license would continue in Suite 406B. Licensed operations in 406A would cease at the end of the day on March 18, 2005, when a close-out survey would be performed. Prior to the close-out survey, sealed sources and contaminated materials would be moved from 406A to 406B. The mailing address should be changed to Suite 406 B.</p> <p>11:15 I left a message for Robert Tokarz, Consulting Medical Physicist, to contact me.</p> <p>13:45 Mr. Tokarz returned my call. I asked him whether the imaging equipment in each suite would remain in its respective suite. He answered that the gamma camera and associated equipment would remain in the current suites. I noted that The license authorized a gamma camera with an attenuation device and asked if it was in Suite 406A or B. Mr. Tokarz indicated that the gamma camera with the attenuation device would be under Tiberiu Kovacs' control in Suite 406B. I thanked Mr. Tokarz for the information.</p>
