<p><u>Summary:</u> Ms. Reichert left voice-mail messages in which she stated that she had submitted detailed diagrams of the facility. She had spoken to Rebecca Junod of the Licensing Assistance Team at the NRC and confirmed that the diagrams had been received. She wanted to know if any additional information was required and when the license could be issued.</p> <p>3/11/2005 09:40 I returned Ms. Reichert's call. I stated that I did not need any additional information from them and had only recently received information from the current licensee of the property. I would be able to proceed with the licensing action. Ms. Reichert then stated that the licensee would not be able to perform any activities until the later part of March. The equipment manufacturer told them that some state-regulated materials would be required for calibration purposes and the state license would require a walk-through by the state inspectors prior to its issuance. I thanked her for the information and that I would proceed as quickly as possible on her amendment request.</p>
