Subject: License amendment			
<p>Summary:</p> <p>Geisinger has submitted a request to add Lewisburg Federal Penitentiary as a location of use. They would like to treat inmates with hyperthyroidism and thyroid carcinoma at the prison as opposed to transporting them to the hospital for treatment. The issue was discussed at the Part 35 meeting and a decision was made to submit the request as a TAR.</p> <p>In the interim, Geisinger would like to administer I-131 to an inmate at Lewisburg Penitentiary who is hyperthyroid, based on a one time deal. The administration would take place at the prison and the inmate would remain in solitary confinement during the course of treatment. In 2003 an amendment to the license permitted the licensee to do a hyperthyroid treatment at the prison based on commitments that were made in the letters dated 5/19/03; 5/28/03 and 6/11/03. The license stated a window of opportunity in which they could treat one inmate. Based on the previous approval to perform a hyperthyroid treatment, Geisinger would like to treat an additional inmate.</p> <p>In order to complete the request, I will need dates between which the treatment would be completed and an updated letter signed by the prison management agreeing to the conditions of the treatment.</p>
