<p>Summary:</p> <p>On February 8, 2005, Geisinger was contacted for additional information concerning the request to perform I-131 therapy treatments at the Lewisburg Federal Penitentiary (on a one-time basis). Items requested included dates between which the treatment would take place and a letter from prison management that agreed to the conditions of the treatment. According to Ms. Anderko the licensee is still attempting to get the letter signed by prison management. I informed her that if we did not receive the information prior to the 90 day mark, we would have to VOID the action and they would need to resubmit at a later date.</p> <p>The original request was to add the prison as a place of use and have Geisinger perform treatments there whenever needed. The issue was discussed at the Part 35 meeting and it was decided that additional information was necessary to make the decision as to whether or not the request would be approved. Ms. Anderko is unsure whether or not the hospital would like to continue with the request or continue submitting requests to treat inmates on a case-by-case basis. Ms. Anderko will get back to me when they make a decision.</p>
