<p><u>Summary:</u> I left messages with Mr. Weichel and Ms. Good to return my call.</p> <p>10:05 Mr. Weichel returned my call. He had confused the annual fee with the renewal of the license. The company had entered Chapter 11 yesterday. He stated that he had been in contact with a Mr. Lito in NRC Rockville and was drafting him a letter informing the NRC of the decision to enter bankruptcy. The gauges are still in secure storage until such time as a new buyer is found for the company. He would fax in a letter requesting that the license be renewed but the status of the license be changed to a "storage only pending restart" option.</p> <p>11:00 I informed Sattar Lodhi, Ph.D. in Region I of the Bankruptcy. He stated that he had spoken with Mr. Weichel earlier this morning and directed him to the regulations involving bankruptcy and the need to notify NRC Headquarters of their entering bankruptcy.</p>
