2. It is requested that Kathleen McDonald, M.D. be removed from our license as she no longer practices medicine at Sacred Heart Hospital.
3. It has been decided by the Radiation Safety Committee of Sacred Heart Hospital in conjunction with the Neurosurgeons with hospital privileges that the GliaSite RTS System (i.e. liquid I-125) be removed from our license.


