Dear Ms. Lanzisera:

This letter is written in follow-up to your recent request for records during your site visit of March 2, 2005. After a thorough investigation, the following sequence of events took place with regards to the sale of the Clinac 4 (Serial number 10-0089) in June 1995:

The Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Resources was notified of the sale of the accelerator in question via letter in June 1995 (copy of letter enclosed). The Accelinear Company, Ltd., who was licensed to possess depleted uranium, performed the removal of the equipment (copy of license enclosed). The actual sale of the linear accelerator was to an oncologist named Dr. Stephen Rush at the Long Island Radiation Therapy facility in Manhasset, NY. Attempts were made to contact Dr. Rush who is currently a member of the Nassau Radiologic Group in New York. We were unable to talk to Dr. Rush but were able to talk to one of the administrators for the group. He told us that the license was in records storage and he would retrieve it. As of this date, he has been unable to locate the license despite numerous calls.

Per your suggestion, we called the State of New York licensing bureau of medical facilities and asked if they could provide a copy of the license in question. They informed us that they have no record of a license for depleted uranium for Dr. Rush.

Approximately three years after Dr. Rush purchased the Clinac 4, he sold it to another firm. Currently Inspectech Corp located in Marinette, Wisconsin owns it (copy of license enclosed).
