Mike,

In our license submittals for the sludge dewatering project, we stated that SFC would move a metal storage shed that we have at the loading dock, to the processing pad area for temporary storage of bagged sludge prior to placement in a storage cell. It turned out that we needed additional storage space for the project, so we purchased a portable canopy and installed it adjacent to the processing pad. We are using the the metal shed for materials storage on the project.

The readiness review team we employed to shake down our project plan identified this as an item that SFC should review in our safety review committee. We did review it, and determined that this change did not affect project safety or our commitments, but that the Staff should be made aware of the change.
