

Regarding license number 45-16209-02, docket 03014703, mail control 136880:

- 1) Instrument: Ludlum Model 14C will be used at the Outpatient Care Center.
- 2) Training: Training will be provided to mammography technologists who assist the Authorized User in dose preparation and administration. Radiation Safety training will be provided to OR staff members (including surgeons) who perform the biopsy procedures and handle the tissue samples.
- 3) Location: The injection will be performed in Mammography room 8.
