Dear Mr. Pocock:

This letter authorizes Solutient to proceed with the modification of the building that originally covered the silos to provide for interim storage of the waste that cannot be shipped at this time. It also authorizes the shipment of the waste that can be shipped at this time that has been discussed with the regulatory authorities over the past month.

This is based upon the conversation between Marie Miller and myself on October 29, 2003 in which she indicated that the type of projects listed above are in line with the type of requests for the use of the NRC funds.

Per quotations from Solutient, the modification of the building will be done on a time and material basis not to exceed \$29,364. This includes the moving and positioning of the drums and boxes in the building. It also includes shielding by B25 boxes to be positioned on the outside of the building. The only extra costs that would be involved would be if the shielding had to be added to for protection of employees. The waste that will ship is 3331.5 Cubic foot at a cost of \$331,251.
