Kessler Memorial Hospital seeks an amendment to change the radiation safety officer to Jonathan N. Law. Mr. Law currently serves as RSO on NRC license 29-08622-04 (the Atlanticare Regional Medical Center) and is a diplomat of the ABR in radiological physics and the ABMP in radiation oncology physics. As RSO, Mr. Law will be given the necessary authority to implement our radiation safety program including support for required corrective actions. Management will financially support reasonable requests for equipment, etc. that are required for ALARA and regulatory requirements. The RSO will periodically visits our site (at least twice per quarter) to review the radiation safety program and conduct radiation safety committee meetings and will be available by phone at all times in case of emergency or for routine questions. In the event of an unlikely emergency the RSO is capable of being on site within one hour. Management has appointed Sharon Wahl, CNMT, Director of Nuclear Medicine as the point of contact in the absence of the RSO.

## ***DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY***

Jonathan N. Law, DABR, DABMP has been appointed Radiation Safety Officer and is responsible for ensuring the safe use of radiation. The Radiation Safety Officer is responsible for managing the radiation safety program; identifying radiation safety problems; initiating, recommending, or providing corrective actions; verifying implementation of corrective actions; and ensuring compliance with regulations. The Radiation Safety Officer is hereby delegated the authority necessary to meet those responsibilities. All authorized users shall recognize this authority and shall follow the recommendations of the RSO to the extent that they are consistent the regulations of the NRC and the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection.
