In accordance with letter dated January 14, 1992, License Number 45-23645-01NA is amended as follows:

License Conditions 18 and 19 are amended to read as follows:

18. A. The licensee shall require permittees to conduct a physical inventory every six months to account for all sources and/or devices received and possessed under their respective permit.
- B. Notwithstanding Paragraph A of this Condition, the licensee may authorize permittees to conduct a physical inventory every twelve months of certain sealed sources and/or devices specified in the letter dated January 14, 1992.
- C. The licensee shall require that permittees maintain records of inventories for five years from the date of each inventory. Records shall include the quantities and kinds of byproduct material, manufacturer's name and model numbers, location of the sources and/or devices, and the date of the inventory.
