Hospira, Inc. Gamma Processing facility located in Rocky Mount, NC currently does not ship or transport radioactive materials quantities of concern (RAMQC). We will however comply with the Order prior to shipment of any RAMQC following the 180-day implementation period of the Order. We will immediately start implementation of the requirements in Attachment B to the Order and shall complete implementation by January 17, 2006, or before shipment of any RAMQC following the 180-day implementation period of the Order. We shall further report to the commission when we have achieved full compliance with the requirements in attachment B of the Order.

Hospira, Inc. plans to use agreements specified in contracts, purchase orders or other manufacturer/vendor documents to achieve compliance with all applicable requirements in attachment B of the order including the use of approved carriers/shippers who will attest to compliance to the Order.
