Subject: Voidance of Request for Crushing/Blending			
<p>Summary:</p> <p>Kevin Taylor called me on Aug. 3 to inform me that Whittaker Corporation will no longer be seeking NRC approval for crushing/blending of licensed material to meet the WAC for WCS. As the licensee has been continuing with segregation of the material, they found that they possess too much Type 1 material and too little Type 2 material to be able to blend to the WAC level. Whittaker is now planning on disposing of the waste as licensed material at a licensed waste facility.</p>			
<p>Action Required/Taken:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) The amendment request for crushing/blending of the material for disposal at WCS also included proposed DCGLs. A TAR was sent to DWM to review each item separately. DWM approved of the DCGLs in a TAR response dated 3/2/05. I spoke with Marie Miller about how to process the amendment request. This phone record will document the voidance of the request for crushing and blending. I may then process the other part of the amendment request, which was acceptance of the DCGLs. 2) This phone record will be placed in ADAMs under the Mail Control for the amendment request. 3) I will then process the license renewal and the amendment approving the DCGLs. 4) SCIENTECH is preparing a new DP to document the new plan for site remediation.
