NALLINCKHOFF CHEMICAL WORKS APPLICATION FOR AMENDMENT OF SSM-33

In reply to your memorandum of March 19, 1958, we have reviewed the information (dated March 14, 1958) submitted by the applicant in reply to our earlier questions.

The subject amendment deals with four processes or operations:

1. Palleting Process
2. Hooded Grinding Operation
3. All-Assay  $\text{UO}_2$  Production Facility
4.  $\text{UO}_2\text{F}_2$  and  $\text{UO}_2(\text{NO}_3)_2$  Facility

If these operations and processes are carried out in accordance with the procedures and with the safeguards and limits outlined in the subject application and amendments, we see no reason, from the standpoint of nuclear safety, why the proposed operations are not acceptable.
