We request you revise question number 23 of the above reference to include the following additional question on the monitor alarm system:

"We have been unable to determine from Attachment III that the outdoor storage areas defined in Sections 502.1, and 502.4 will be adequately covered by the monitor alarm system. Please show the maximum limits of these storage areas on your drawing in Attachment III, making any necessary relocations and/or additions to your present monitor alarm system to adequately cover those areas. Also, the above comments apply to the storage racks in Section 600.1.1."

In our memo, Luke to Nussbaumer, dated March 19, 1964, we recommended that UNC's container identified as RE Permit 1483 be evaluated in terms of a 30-foot drop, a full one-hour fire test, and 24-hour submersion under 3 feet of water. This evaluation of this container is necessary because UNC has requested the shipment of solutions therein, and it is mandatory that the solution will be contained in safe geometry after the full series of tests. Therefore, we suggest that you request this evaluation at the earliest possible date.
