UNITED NUCLEAR CORPORATION - OPERATOR TRAINING

I received a telephone call from Dr. H. H. Woodruff, OS, on Sunday, August 3, 1964. He said that late Friday (July 31, 1964) George Kley, OS, took a call from a Mr. London of United Nuclear Corporation (UNC), New Haven, Connecticut. (The latter's telephone number is Area Code 203 and 777-5361, extension 440.) Mr. London wanted to know what training courses were available in the AEC on the subject of criticality for operators of fuel processing plants. Undoubtedly the question was suggested by the criticality incident at the Wood River Junction plant, Rhode Island, of UNC on July 24, 1964.
