The Division of Technical Information has informed us that there is a proposal "in the mill" for the updating of the handbook, "Medical Aspects of Radiation Accidents" which is an AEC publication. This would involve a contract with Dr. Eugene L. Saenger, who was the editor of the original publication. In connection with the project, Dr. Saenger would like to have access to information which is in the files of Compliance or in Compliance investigative reports. Specifically, he would like to have information concerning the frequency and the scope of various types of radiation incidents. In addition, he would like to use case histories as examples. The Division of Technical Information states that in using any particular incident as an example, care will be exercised not to identify licensees or individuals. The final text of any information utilized will be reviewed by Compliance (and OGC) to insure that our policies on privileged information are not violated.

Unless you disagree, we propose to cooperate with the Division of Technical Information in this matter and make investigation information available to them.

Dr. Saenger is one of the medical consultants utilized by the Division of Compliance.
