Dear Mr. Nussbaumer:

United Nuclear requests authorization to store at its Fuels Recovery Plant, Wood River Junction, Rhode Island a total of seven truckloads of enriched uranium scrap to be received in the month of December as follows:

Each container in the incoming shipments will be spaced in accordance with Table 10 TID 7019 with the spacing provided by empty 55 gallon drums. Each array (shipment) will be separated by at least 12 feet from any SNM. All storage will be in a planar array one container high. Any incoming shipments that are double stacked or do not meet the above criteria will be split into at least two portions each separated by 12 feet.

Storage areas will be inside the perimeter fence in areas covered by existing radiation detection monitors and alarms.

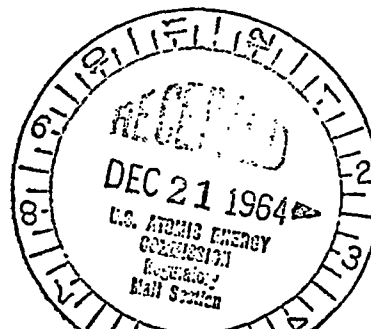
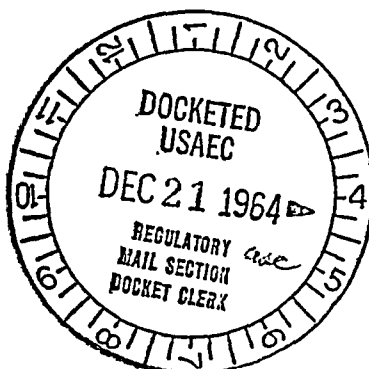
