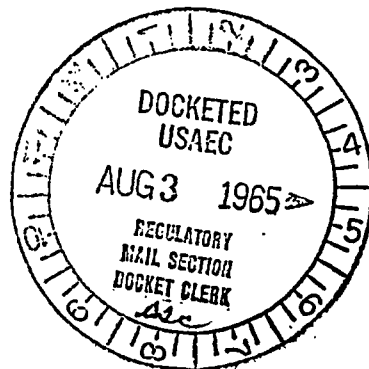
Please amend license SNM-777 to permit the establishment of a storage area of 5-inch pipes in a horizontal plane on 16" centers. Separation between pipes will be provided by concrete blocks at each end or similar rigid non-combustible structural material. Pipes will be supported 6" off the ground, minimum. Material to be stored in these pipes will be Uranium alloy (U-Al or zirc scrap chips and solids) or Uranium oxide or other compounds containing less than 3.2 gms U-235 per cc. This array to be built in east or south storage yard areas already covered by radiation monitors and alarms. An exclusion distance of 12' will be maintained, by proper barriers and/or signs, from other special nuclear materials.

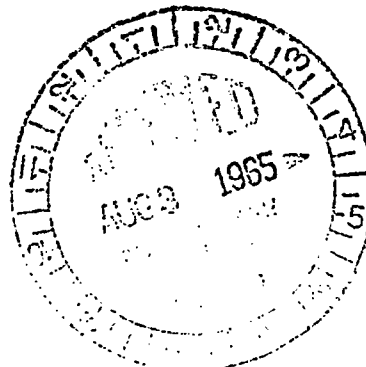
