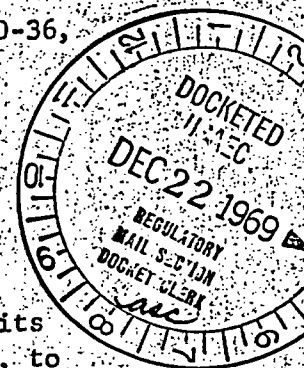
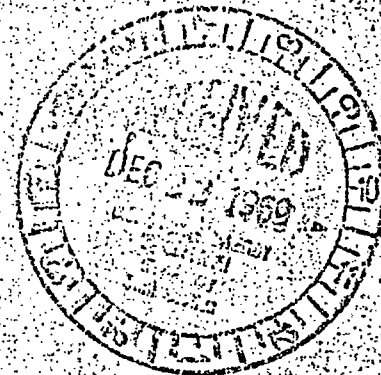

Dear Mr. Nussbaumer:

United Nuclear Corporation respectfully requests amendment of its Special Nuclear Material Licenses SNM-33 and 777, respectively, to include the new shipping container Model UNC-1352. This container will replace the Model UNC-1351 when its DOT special permit expires on February 28, 1970.

The Model UNC-1352 is identical in all respects to the DOT specification 6M container with the exception of the dimensions of the inner container. The inner container diameter is that of a 6-inch schedule 40 pipe, whereas the 6M specification limits the diameter to 5½ inches. This larger diameter is required in order to ship our standard high enriched uranium metal biscuit; the diameter of this biscuit is approximately 5½ inches.

In support of this application, pages 1 and 2, dated 12/19/69, of Subsection 703, are submitted. These provide a full description and safety evaluation of the container.


