Dear Mr. Wroblewski:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 102 to your NRC Material License No. 13-00133-02 in accordance with your request. Please note that the changes made to your license are printed in **bold** font.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

This amendment authorizes Morris Bank, Ph.D. as an Authorized Medical Physicist (AMP) for your license. In a telephone conversation between you and me on August 24, 2005, I accepted Dr. Bank as an AMP for your license based upon new information you provided to me consisting of a current license that names Dr. Bank as an AMP for the same primary use that you have on your license, i.e., high dose rate remote afterloading brachytherapy (HDR use). I verified Dr. Bank's licensure on the referenced license and accepted that in lieu of a response to the telephone conversation record I sent to you via facsimile on August 23, 2005, which is hereby withdrawn.

I also updated your AMP authorization in accordance with your instructions in the telephone call on August 24, 2005. Please note that your Conditions have been re-numbered as a result of this update. In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter will be available electronically in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records (PARS) component of NRC's document system (ADAMS). The NRC's document system is accessible from the NRC Web site at <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html>. The enclosed license document is exempt from public disclosure in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390, because its disclosure to unauthorized individuals could present a security vulnerability.

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions.

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Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.
