SUBJECT: TRIP REPORT - COMBUSTION ENGINEERING

On December 8 and 9, 1982, I participated with representatives from NMSS in a meeting at the licensee's Hematite facility to discuss renewal of license SNM-33 which authorizes production of low-enriched uranium oxide power and pellets from uranium hexafluoride. The license expired March 31, 1982, and the licensee is operating in timely renewal on the basis of a renewal application submitted in February 1982.

The meeting was useful in that it served to familiarize the NMSS people with the plant and its management. Discussions disclosed no major problems in the license renewal process. The next step in the licensing process will be NMSS' submittal to the licensee of a request for additional information and changes in the license, many of which were agreed on during the meeting.
