Dear Mr. Bauser:

This is to inform the Joint Committee that the Atomic Energy Commission plans to issue a license to Gulf United Nuclear Fuel Corporation, for the export to Canada of 21.2 kilograms of special nuclear material.

The uranium to be exported is in metallic form enriched to 93.3% and will be shipped to The Hydro-Electric Power Commission of Ontario, Toronto, Canada, for manufacture of booster assemblies for the Bruce Nuclear Generating Station.

The proposed export of special nuclear material is within the scope of the Agreement for Cooperation Concerning Civil Uses of Atomic Energy Between the Government of the United States of America and the Government of Canada which entered into force on July 21, 1955, and is subject to its terms and conditions.
