Dear Mr. Bauser:

This is to inform the Joint Committee that the Atomic Energy Commission intends to issue a license to Gulf United Nuclear Fuels Corporation for the export of 34.8 kilograms of uranium 235 to Japan.

The uranium 235 is contained in 37.25 kilograms of metallic uranium, an enrichment of 93.3%. The ultimate consignee, Japan Atomic Energy Research Institute, Tokyo, Japan, has stated that the special nuclear material will be made into plate type fuels for the Japan Material Testing Reactor, Ibaragi-ken, Japan and for the Japan Research Reactor II, Ibaragi-ken, Japan.

The proposed export of special nuclear material is within the scope of the Agreement for Cooperation Between the Government of the United States of America and the Government of Japan Concerning Civil Uses of Atomic Energy, which entered into force July 10, 1968, and is subject to its terms and conditions.
