Gentlemen:

Pursuant to 10 CFR 71 the United Nuclear Corporation is hereby authorized under Special Nuclear Material Licenses SNM-33, SNM-368 and SNM-777 to ship uranium-bearing solutions in accordance with the procedures described in application dated May 26, 1964, and supplements dated May 27, and June 2, 1964. As a condition of this authorization, the United Nuclear Corporation is required to assure that, prior to shipment, the contents of each shipping container do not exceed (1) five (5) grams U-235 per liter of solution and (2) a total of 800 grams of U-235. All other conditions of these licenses shall remain the same.

Two signed copies of this amendment are enclosed so that distribution may be made to your Hematite, Missouri, and Wood River Junction, Rhode Island, plants.
