Gentlemen:

In accordance with your application dated January 12, 1979, as supplemented March 8, 1979, and pursuant to Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 70, Special Nuclear Material License No. SNM-33 is hereby amended to include your decommissioning plan and financial commitment. Accordingly, Condition 22 is added to your license to read as follows:

Condition 22. At the end of the plant life, the licensee shall decontaminate the facilities and site in accordance with the general decommissioning plan submitted in the enclosure to the letter dated January 12, 1979, so that these facilities and grounds can be released to unrestricted use. The financial commitment to assure that funds will be available for decommissioning, in the letter dated March 8, 1979, is hereby incorporated as a condition of the license.

All other conditions of this license shall remain the same.

Gentlemen:

In accordance with your application dated August 16, 1976, and supplements dated October 8, 29, and December 22, 1976, and June 3, 1977, and pursuant to Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Parts 40 and 70, Materials License No. SNM-33 is hereby amended to authorize the operation of your wet scrap recovery process line, subject to the following condition:

Liquid waste from this system shall not be discharged to the on-site evaporation ponds.

Item 8C of SNM-33 is amended to increase the authorized quantity of source material from 2,000 to 20,000 kilograms.

All other conditions of this license shall remain the same.

The above condition was discussed and agreed upon between your Mr. J. Rode and W. T. Crow of my staff.
