Hi Bill,

I wanted to provide clarification to our conversation yesterday and my subsequent email concerning the Class III protection levels. I did not realize that the Class III levels are only applicable to NEW facilities.

Since the Lisbon site is an existing facility and the ground water has already been contaminated, it falls under the Corrective Action portion of our regulations (R317-6.15). It is also under this section where there are provisions for ACLs, which are risk-based, and probably follow a path similar to your own regs.

Loren Morten provided me with this clarification. We had a conference call with Paul this afternoon which is when this surfaced. Paul has invited Loren and me to participate in your conference call tomorrow. Loren has much more experience with this than me, and can provide any additional clarification you may need. Sorry for any confusion I may have caused. Talk to you tomorrow.
