SYNOPSIS

This investigation was initiated on September 8, 2004, by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Office of Investigations, Region III, to determine if a Radiation Protection Technician at the Palisades Nuclear Power Plant was discriminated against for raising safety issues to the NRC.

Based on the evidence developed, this investigation did not substantiate the allegation that a Radiation Protection Technician at the Palisades Nuclear Power Plant was discriminated against for raising safety issues to the NRC (Allegation No. RIII-2004-A-0096).
