SUBJECT:               TEMPORARY STAGING OF MATERIALS FOR OFF-SITE SHIPMENT

Dear Mr. Jackson:

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission has completed its examination of the Phase 1 Work Plan for remediation of the Muskogee site. In response to your question, the staff agrees that the dried material from Ponds 2 and 3 may be **staged** in the adjacent area, until September 30, 2006, in preparation for shipment to IUC, and is not subject to the storage requirements of Condition 25 of SMB-911. This is described in Section 3.6 Storage, Part B of SMB-911, as a definition of the transportation preparation and packaging area function during Phase I activities; pallets will not be used. Retaining the material on-site past the specified date will be deemed to be storage and subject to the requirements of License Condition 25.
