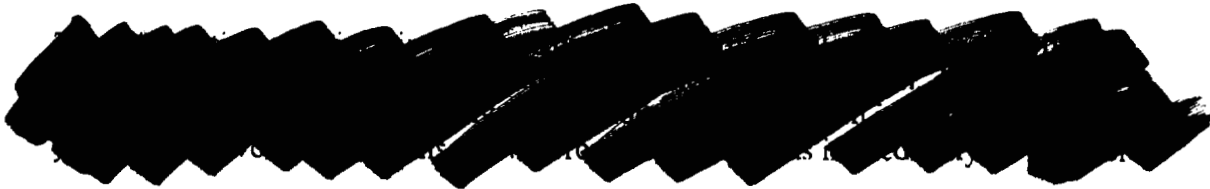

At this time, we anticipate no changes in the program.
