Dear Mr. Gotti:

On May 19, 2005, Mr. Todd Jackson of this office conducted a safety inspection at 713-B Harris Street, Charlottesville, Virginia of activities authorized by the above listed NRC licenses. The inspection was an examination of your licensed activities as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's regulations and the license conditions. The inspection consisted of observations by the inspector, interviews with personnel, and a selected examination of representative records. Additional information provided in your correspondence dated May 24, 2005, and July 27, 2005, and the telephone conversations on July 25 and July 27, 2005, between Dr. Willie Regits of your organization and this office, were also examined as part of the inspection. Our review of the inspection information continued through September 9, 2005. The findings of the inspection were discussed with Mr. Craig Barlow of the Charlottesville facility at the conclusion of the inspection, and with Dr. Regits following our receipt of the additional information.

Within the scope of this inspection, no violations were identified.
