SUBJECT: INCREASED CONTROLS FOR RADIOACTIVE MATERIAL QUANTITIES OF CONCERN

This letter is to ensure you are aware that the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), working cooperatively with the Organization of Agreement States, Inc., and individual Agreement States, has developed and is currently enhancing controls for radioactive materials licensees possessing radioactive material quantities of concern. These controls will supplement existing requirements and when implemented by licensees, will contribute to ensuring that our common objectives of enhancing control over certain radioactive sources and protecting public health and safety will continue to be met.

The increased controls are being issued consistent with the existing Agreements with States, under Section 274b of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, for protection of public health and safety. The issuance of these controls is also consistent with ongoing national and international efforts to address the potential health and safety hazards that could be posed by the loss of control over such radioactive sources. This approach to issuing the increased controls will maximize the effectiveness and efficiency of NRC and Agreement State inspection resources by inspecting safety and control requirements in an integrated manner.

The NRC staff provided copies of the increased controls to Agreement State Radiation Control Program Directors on September 2, 2005. The NRC and the Agreement States will complete the issuance of the increased controls in December 2005.
