Subject: REGION II RESPONSE TO HURRICANE WILMA

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission Region II office activated its Incident Response Center at 7:00 p.m. (EDT) on October 23, 2005. Region II is in the Monitoring Mode in response to Hurricane Wilma as it nears the coast of Florida. NRC inspectors are currently at the nuclear plant site and are reviewing preparations for the impending severe weather.

The Turkey Point site declared a Notice of Unusual Event on October 22 at 10:54 p.m. (EDT) due to a Hurricane Warning being issued for portions of the State of Florida. Unit 3 is currently operating at 60 percent power and Unit 4 is currently operating at 80 percent power. The licensee is conducting a controlled power reduction on both units and is monitoring projections for potential hurricane force winds onsite.

The Federal Emergency Management Agency Region IV has also activated their Regional Coordination Center to monitor the hurricane. The State of Florida has been notified.

The information presented herein was discussed with the licensee and is current as of 00:15 a.m. (EDT) October 24, 2005.

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
